According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 4.6 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 21, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 23 percent short, 59 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent very short, 35 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 6 percent surplus.
