According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 2.4 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, August 28, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent very short, 14 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 14 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 28 percent short, 50 percent adequate, and 15 percent surplus.
