Corn Planted Acreage Up 23 Percent from 2018

Cotton Planted Acreage Up 13 Percent

Rice Planted Acreage Up 7 Percent

Soybean Planted Acreage Down 13 Percent

Mississippi **corn** planted area for all purpose is estimated at 590,000 acres, up 110,000 acres from a year ago but down 10,000 acres from March planting intentions.

Upland cotton planted acres is estimated at 700,000, up 80,000 acres from a year ago and up 20,000 acres from March planting intentions.

All hay expected to be harvested is estimated at 600,000 acres, up 10,000 acres from a year ago and up 10,000 acres from March intentions.

Peanuts planted area is estimated at 25,000 acres, unchanged from a year ago but up 5,000 acres from March planting intentions.

All rice planted area for 2019 is estimated at 150,000 acres, up 10,000 acres from a year ago but unchanged from March planting intentions.

Soybeans planted area is estimated at 1.95 million acres, down 280,000 acres from a year ago and down 50,000 acres from March planting intentions.

Winter wheat planted acres is estimated at 40,000 acres, down 15,000 acres from a year ago but up 5,000 acres from March estimates. Wheat acres intended to be harvested for grain this year is estimated at 20,000, down 10,000 acres from the 2018 harvest.






Corn: Area Planted - Mississippi and United States: 1999 - 2019
