Corn Yield and Production Unchanged from October Cotton Yield and Production Unchanged from October Rice Yield and Production Down from October Soybean Yield and Production Unchanged from October

Mississippi corn for grain production is forecast at 91.9 million bushels, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but down 28 percent from 2021. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 167 bushels per acre, unchanged from last month but down 14 bushels from last year. Producers expect to harvest 550,000 acres of corn for grain, down 150,000 acres from 2021.

Upland cotton production is forecast at 1.10 million bales, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but 207,000 bales above last year. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 1,006 pounds per harvested acre, unchanged from last month but up 9 pounds from 2021. Harvested acreage is estimated at 525,000 acres, up 95,000 acres from 2021.

Peanut production in 2022 is forecast at 53.3 million pounds, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but down 24 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 4,100 pounds per acre, unchanged from last month and unchanged from last year. Area for harvest, at 13,000 acres, is down 4,000 acres from 2021.

All rice production for the state is forecast at 6.22 million hundredweight, down 1 percent from the October 1 forecast and down 18 percent from last year's production of 7.54 million hundredweight. Based on conditions as of November 1, the all rice yield for 2022 is forecast at 7,400 pounds per acre, down 100 pounds from last month and down 140 pounds from last year. Producers expect to harvest 84,000 acres, down 16,000 acres from 2021.

Soybean production in 2022 is forecast at 128 million bushels, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but up 9 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of November 1, yield is expected to average 56 bushels per acre, unchanged from last month but up 2 bushels from last year. Area for harvest, at 2.28 million acres, is up 110,000 acres from 2021.






