Corn Yield and Production Up from 2022 Cotton Yield Up but Production Down from 2022 Rice Yield and Production Up from 2022 Soybean Yield and Production Up from 2022

Mississippi **corn** for grain production is forecast at 125 million bushels, up 34 percent from 2022. Based on conditions as of August 1, yield is expected to average 179 bushels per acre, up 14 bushels from last year. Producers expect to harvest 700,000 acres of corn for grain, up 135,000 acres from 2022.

Upland cotton production is forecast at 860,000 bales, down 27 percent, or 326,000 bales below last year. Based on conditions as of August 1, yield is expected to average 1,101 pounds per harvested acre, up 17 pounds from 2022. Producers expect to harvest 375,000 acres of cotton, down 150,000 acres from 2022.

Hay production, excluding alfalfa, is forecast at 1.14 million tons, down 3 percent from 2022. Based on conditions as of August 1, yield is expected to average 1.90 tons per acre, down 0.10 ton per acre from last year. Producers expect to harvest 600,000 acres of hay, excluding alfalfa, up 10,000 acres from 2022.

Peanut production in 2023 is forecast at 66.0 million pounds, up 5 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of August 1, yield is expected to average 4,400 pounds per acre, down 100 pounds from last year. Area for harvest, at 15,000 acres, is up 1,000 acres from 2022.

All rice production for the state is forecast at 7.25 million hundredweight, up 17 percent from last year's production of 6.19 million hundredweight. Based on conditions as of August 1, the all rice yield for 2023 is forecast at 7,400 pounds per acre, up 30 pounds from last year. Producers expect to harvest 98,000 acres of rice, up 14,000 acres from 2022.

Soybean production in 2023 is forecast at 127 million bushels, up 3 percent from last year. Based on conditions as of August 1, yield is expected to average 56 bushels per acre, up 2 bushels from last year. Area for harvest, at 2.27 million acres, is down 20,000 acres from 2022.
