2020 Mississippi Total Value of Production for Field Crops Up 18 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Mississippi during 2020 totaled \$2.29 billion, up 18 percent from 2019. The top three crop commodities, soybeans, cotton, and corn, accounted for 78 percent of the total value of production for field crops. Soybeans showed the largest increase at 66 percent in value of production from last year, followed by sweet potatoes at 62 percent. Cotton in Mississippi showed the largest percentage decrease from 2019 at 24 percent, followed by corn at 22 percent and winter wheat at 3 percent. The value of production for sweet potatoes during 2020 totaled \$122 million, up 62 percent from 2019.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was up 21 percent, at \$159 billion, from 2019. Corn, at \$61.0 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$46.1 billion and all hay at \$17.3 billion.




