2022 Mississippi Total Value of Production for Field Crops Up 12 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Mississippi during 2022 totaled \$3.37 billion, includes sweet potato value of production, up 12 percent from 2021. The top three crop commodities, soybeans, corn, and cotton, accounted for 85 percent of the total value of production for field crops. Cottonseed showed the largest increase at 81 percent in value of production from last year, followed by winter wheat at 31 percent. Corn for grain in Mississippi showed the largest percentage decrease from 2021 at 9 percent, followed by sweet potatoes at 5 percent. The value of production for sweet potatoes during 2022 totaled \$91.5 million, down 5 percent from 2021.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was up 3 percent, at \$219 billion, from 2021. Corn, at \$91.7 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$61.1 billion and all hay at \$21.3 billion.

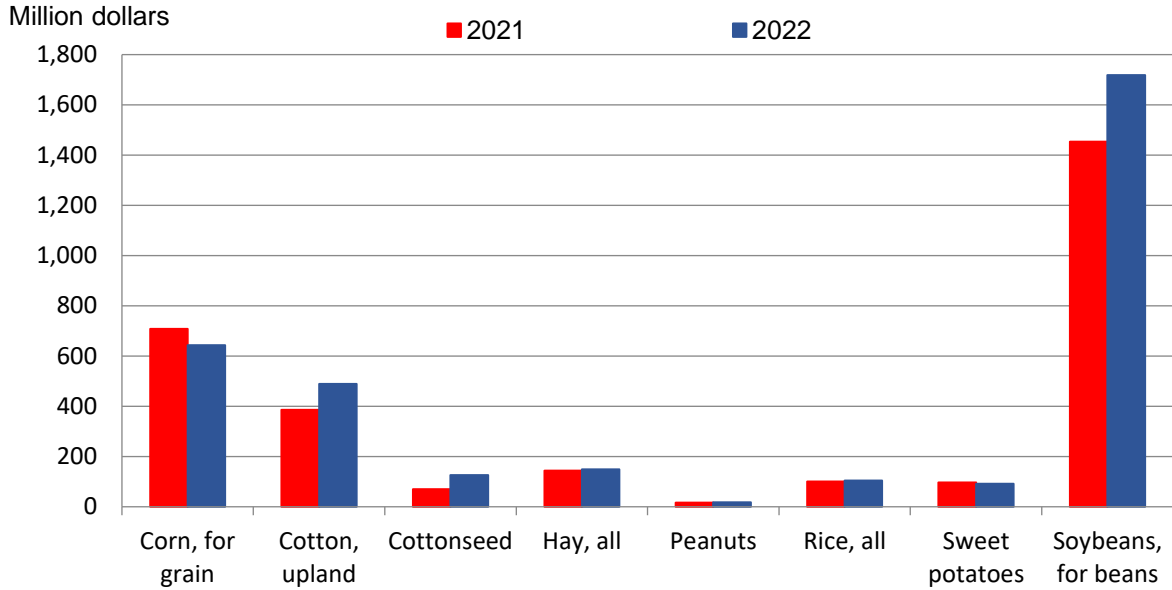
