### 2023 Mississippi Total Value of Production for Field Crops Down 7 Percent

The value of production for field crops in Mississippi during 2023 totaled \$3.15 billion, includes sweet potato value of production, down 7 percent from 2022. The top three crop commodities, soybeans, cotton, and corn, accounted for 84 percent of the total value of production for field crops. Rice showed the largest increase at 33 percent in value of production from last year, followed by corn at 16 percent. Cotton in Mississippi showed the largest percentage decrease from 2022 at 42 percent, followed by cottonseed at 33 percent. The value of production for sweet potatoes during 2023 totaled \$80.7 million, down 16 percent from 2022.

At the national level, the value of production for field crops was down 12 percent, at \$191 billion, from 2022. Corn, at \$73.9 billion, was the leading field crop followed by soybeans at \$52.8 billion and all hay at \$21.3 billion.


