






**Mississippi Chick Placements Up 2 Percent from Last Year**

Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Mississippi were 13.8 million during the week ending November 21, 2015. Placements were up 2 percent from the comparable week in 2014 but down 6 percent from the previous week.

Mississippi hatcheries set 17.8 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending November 21, 2015, down 1 percent from the same period last year but up 2 percent from the previous week.

Leading breeders in the **United States** placed 6.83 million **broiler-type pullet chicks** for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during October 2015, up slightly percent from October 2014.

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Down 1 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 215 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 21, 2015, down 1 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 207 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 21, 2015, down 1 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 167 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 21, 2015, up 1 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 161 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 21, 2015, up 1 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 10, 2015 through November 21, 2015 for the United States were 8.05 billion. Cumulative placements were up 2 percent from the same period a year earlier.
