Broiler-Type Eggs Set Up 7 Percent from Last Year

Mississippi hatcheries set 16.4 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending September 2, 2023, up 7 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but down 5 percent from the previous week.

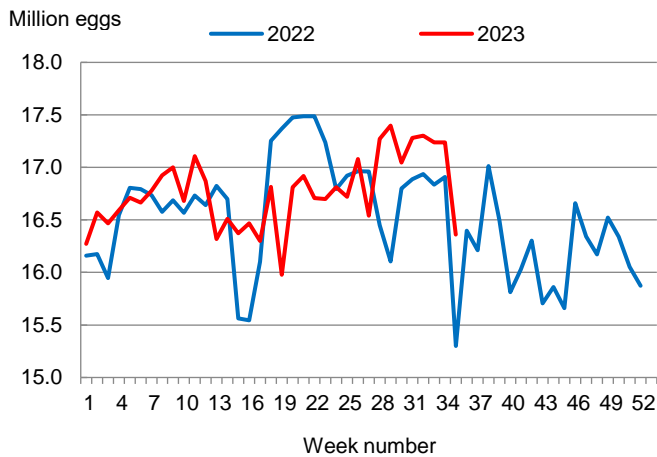
Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 239 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 2, 2023, down 1 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Down 1 Percent

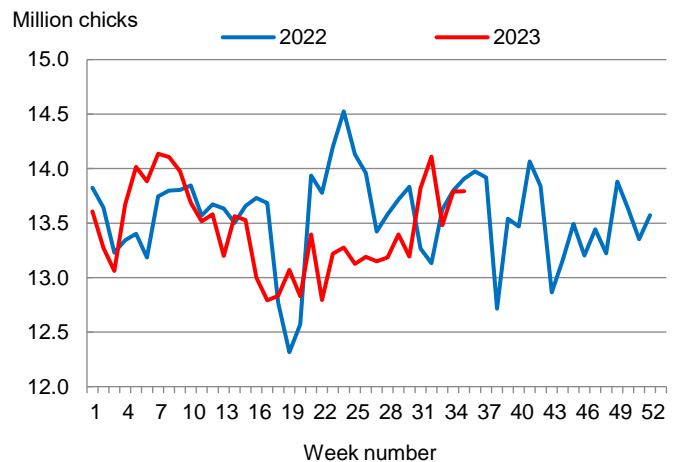
Mississippi broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 13.8 million chicks during the week ending September 2, 2023, down 1 percent from the comparable week in 2022 but up slightly from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 190 million chicks for meat production during the week ending September 2, 2023, down 2 percent from a year ago.
