Second Quarter Milk Production Down 9 Percent

Mississippi milk production during the April - June 2015 quarter was 48 million pounds, down 6 percent from the same period in 2014 and down 9 percent from the January-March 2015 quarter. The average number of milk cows on farms during the quarter was 12,000 head, 1,000 head fewer from the same period last year but unchanged from the previous quarter.

Milk production in the United States during the April - June quarter totaled 53.6 billion pounds, up 1.4 percent from the April - June quarter last year.

The average number of milk cows in the United States during the quarter was 9.32 million head, 14,000 head more than the January - March quarter, and 66,000 head more than the same period last year.
