Second Quarter Milk Production Down 15 Percent from Last Year

Mississippi milk production during the April – June 2016 quarter was 40 million pounds, down 15 percent from the same period in 2015 and down 5 percent from the January – March 2016 quarter. The average number of milk cows on farms during the quarter was 10,000 head, down 2,000 head from the same period last year but unchanged from the previous quarter.

Milk Production in the United States during the April – June quarter totaled 54.4 billion pounds, up 1.2 percent from the January - March quarter last year.

The average number of milk cows in the United States during the quarter was 9.33 million head, 8,000 head more than the January -March 2016 quarter, and 6,000 head more than the same period last year.
