

#### Mississippi January 1 All Cattle Inventory Down 5 Percent

All cattle and calves in Mississippi as of January 1, 2023, totaled 860,000 head, were down 5 percent from January 1, 2022. The calf crop for the full year of 2022 was 370,000 head, down 5 percent from last year. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 455,000 head, were down 6 percent from January 1, 2022; beef cows, at 449,000 head, were down 6 percent; and milk cows, at 6,000 head, were down 14 percent from 2022. All heifers weighing 500 pounds and over were down 7 percent at 125,000 head. Steers were up 4 percent at 54,000 head; bulls were down 8 percent at 36,000 head; and calves weighing less than 500 pounds were down 5 percent at 190,000 head.

Meat and other goat inventory in Mississippi, on January 1, 2023, totaled 19,000 head, unchanged from the previous year.


