

## Mississippi January 1 All Cattle Inventory Down 5 Percent

All cattle and calves in Mississippi as of January 1, 2024, totaled 810,000 head, were down 5 percent from January 1, 2023. The calf crop for the full year of 2023 was 345,000 head, down 4 percent from last year. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 430,000 head, were down 3 percent from January 1, 2023; beef cows, at 424,000 head, were down 3 percent; and milk cows, at 6,000 head, were unchanged from 2023. All heifers weighing 500 pounds and over were down 3 percent at 118,000 head. Steers were down 7 percent at 53,000 head; bulls were down 6 percent at 34,000 head; and calves weighing less than 500 pounds were down 8 percent at 175,000 head.

Meat and other goat inventory in Mississippi, on January 1, 2024, totaled 21,000 head, up 11 percent from the previous year.


