## August Egg Production Up 5 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Mississippi totaled 122 million eggs during August 2022, down 3 percent from the previous month but up 5 percent from August 2021. The number of layers during August 2022 averaged 5.68 million, down 1 percent from the previous month but up 7 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,143 eggs, down 2 percent from the previous month and down 1 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 9.10 billion during August 2022, down 2 percent from last year. The average number of layers during August 2022 totaled 371 million, down 3 percent from last year. August egg production per 100 layers was 2,450 eggs, up 2 percent from August 2021.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Down 3 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Mississippi during August 2022 totaled 60.9 million, down 3 percent from August 2021.
Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during August 2022 totaled 865 million, up 3 percent from August 2021.
