## September Egg Production Up 6 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Mississippi totaled 117 million eggs during September 2022, down 4 percent from the previous month but up 6 percent from September 2021. The number of layers during September 2022 averaged 5.69 million, down slightly from the previous month but up 7 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,062 eggs, down 4 percent from the previous month and down 1 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 8.83 billion during September 2022, down 3 percent from last year. The average number of layers during September 2022 totaled 373 million, down 3 percent from last year. September egg production per 100 layers was 2,365 eggs, up 1 percent from September 2021.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Down 1 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Mississippi during September 2022 totaled 58.8 million, down 1 percent from September 2021.

Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during September 2022 totaled 839 million, up 5 percent from September 2021.
