## February Egg Production Down 4 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Mississippi totaled 105 million eggs during February 2023, down 8 percent from the previous month and down 4 percent from February 2022. The number of layers during February 2023 averaged 5.38 million, up slightly from the previous month but down 3 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 1,951 eggs, down 9 percent from the previous month and down 1 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 8.23 billion during February 2023, down 5 percent from last year. The average number of layers during February 2023 totaled 379 million, down 3 percent from last year. February egg production per 100 layers was 2,171 eggs, down 2 percent from February 2022.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Up 1 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Mississippi during February 2023 totaled 55.0 million, up 1 percent from February 2022.
Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during February 2023 totaled 763 million, up 1 percent from February 2022.
