## July Egg Production Down 5 Percent from Last Year

Egg production in Mississippi totaled 119 million eggs during July 2023, up 3 percent from the previous month but down 5 percent from July 2022. The number of layers during July 2023 averaged 5.59 million, down 1 percent from the previous month and down 2 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,129 eggs, up 3 percent from the previous month but down 3 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 9.37 billion during July 2023, up 3 percent from last year. The average number of layers during July 2023 totaled 384 million, up 4 percent from last year. July egg production per 100 layers was 2,438 eggs, down slightly from July 2022.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Down 2 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Mississippi during July 2023 totaled 61.0 million, down 2 percent from July 2022.
Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during July 2023 totaled 848 million, down 1 percent from July 2022.
