



# Missouri Hogs and Pigs

Released December 23, 2015

**Missouri inventory** of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2015 was 3.00 million head, down 2 percent from September 1, 2015 but up 5 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 395,000 head, was down 1 percent from the previous quarter and last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 2.61 million head, was down 2 percent from last quarter but up 6 percent from last year.

**The September-November 2015 pig crop**, at 1.98 million head, was down 1 percent from 2014. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 190,000 head, down 10 percent from last year. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.40 for the September-November period, compared with 9.50 last year.


