



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2016

**Corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2016 totaled 209 million bushels, down 23 percent from March 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 125 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 84.1 million bushels. The December 2015 - February 2016 indicated disappearance is 107 million bushels, down 13 percent from the same period last year.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2016 totaled 73.2 million bushels, up 3 percent from March 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 41.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 32.2 million bushels. The December 2015 - February 2016 indicated disappearance is 56.9 million bushels, down 22 percent from the same period last year.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2016 totaled 20.5 million bushels, down slightly from March 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 4.50 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 16.0 million bushels. The December 2015 - February 2016 indicated disappearance is 3.64 million bushels, down 3 percent from the same period last year.
