



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 30, 2016

**Corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 102 million bushels, down 30 percent from June 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 52.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 50.2 million bushels. The March - May 2016 indicated disappearance is 108 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 34.4 million bushels, up 1 percent from June 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 9.70 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 24.7 million bushels. The March - May 2016 indicated disappearance is 39.0 million bushels.

**Old crop all wheat** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2016 totaled 15.1 million bushels, up 6 percent from June 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 1.70 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 13.4 million bushels. The March - May 2016 indicated disappearance is 5.38 million bushels.
