



# Missouri Hogs and Pigs

Released December 23, 2016

**Missouri inventory** of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2016 was 3.1 million head, down 3 percent from Sept 1, 2016 but up 2 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 435,000 head, was up 40,000 from the previous quarter and last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 2.67 million head, was down 5 percent from last quarter and up slightly from last year.

**The Sep-Nov 2016 pig crop**, at 2.2 million head, was up 8 percent from 2015. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 210,000 head, up 15,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.45 for the Sep-Nov period, compared with 10.40 last year.


