



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released January 12, 2017

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2016 totaled 376 million bushels, up 19 percent from December 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 260 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 116 million bushels. The September - November 2016 indicated disappearance is 240 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2016 totaled 151 million bushels, up 16 percent from December 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 90.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 61.1 million bushels. The September - November 2016 indicated disappearance is 131 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2016 totaled 28.8 million bushels, up 19 percent from December 1, 2015. On-farm stocks totaled 3.75 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 25.1 million bushels. The September - November 2016 indicated disappearance is 12.1 million bushels.
