



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2017

**Corn** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017 totaled 243 million bushels, up 15 percent from March 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 155 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 88.3 million bushels. The December 2016 - February 2017 indicated disappearance is 132 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017 totaled 82.5 million bushels, up 12 percent from March 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 43.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 39.5 million bushels. The December 2016 - February 2017 indicated disappearance is 68.7 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017 totaled 23.3 million bushels, up 14 percent from March 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 1.50 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 21.8 million bushels. The December 2016 - February 2017 indicated disappearance is 5.56 million bushels.
