



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 30, 2017

Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2017 totaled 125 million bushels, up 22 percent from June 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 73.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 51.9 million bushels. The March - May 2017 indicated disappearance is 118 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 2017 totaled 48.9 million bushels, up 42 percent from June 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 24.5 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 24.4 million bushels. The March - May 2017 indicated disappearance is 33.6 million bushels.

Old crop all wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 2017 totaled 18.5 million bushels, up 23 percent from June 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 690 thousand bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 17.8 million bushels. The March - May 2017 indicated disappearance is 4.75 million bushels.
