



# Missouri Hogs and Pigs

Released September 28, 2017

**Missouri inventory** of all hogs and pigs on September 1, 2017 was 3.50 million head, up 6 percent from June 1, 2017 and up 9 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 440,000 head, was unchanged from the previous quarter but up 45,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 3.06 million head, was up 7 percent from last quarter and up 9 percent from last year.

**The June-August 2017 pig crop**, at 2.39 million head, was up 10 percent from 2016. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 235,000 head, up 20,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.15 for the June-August period, compared with 10.10 last year.


