



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released September 29, 2017

**Old crop corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2017 totaled 59.4 million bushels, up 32 percent from September 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 26.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 33.4 million bushels. The June - August 2017 indicated disappearance is 65.6 million bushels.

**Old crop soybean** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2017 totaled 15.6 million bushels, up 50 percent from September 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 6.50 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 9.12 million bushels. The June - August 2017 indicated disappearance is 33.4 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2017 totaled 40.8 million bushels, down slightly from September 1, 2016. On-farm stocks totaled 5.10 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 35.7 million bushels. The June - August 2017 indicated disappearance is 14.4 million bushels.
