



Missouri Small Grains 2018 Summary

Released September 28, 2018

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2018 is estimated at 520,000 acres, down 4 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is estimated at 59 bushels per acre, down 9 bushels from 2017. Production is estimated at 30.7 million bushels, 16 percent below the previous year.

Oats: Harvested area in 2018, at 16,000 acres, is up 3,000 acres from the previous year. The oat yield is estimated at 45 bushels per acre, down 20 bushels from 2017. Production is estimated at 720,000 bushels, 15 percent below the previous year.
