



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released February 8, 2019

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2018 totaled 348 million bushels, down 17 percent from December 1, 2017. On-farm stocks totaled 245 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 103 million bushels. The September - November 2018 indicated disappearance is 170 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2018 totaled 189 million bushels, down 6 percent from December 1, 2017. On-farm stocks totaled 120 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 68.9 million bushels. The September - November 2018 indicated disappearance is 91.9 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2018 totaled 28.1 million bushels, down 14 percent from December 1, 2017. On-farm stocks totaled 3.10 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 25.0 million bushels. The September - November 2018 indicated disappearance is 7.14 million bushels.
