Released February 28, 2019


**All cattle and calves** as of January 1, 2019 totaled 4.25 million head, 2 percent below January 1, 2018. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 2.14 million head, are down 1 percent from a year ago. The 2018 calf crop was estimated at 1.94 million head, down 1 percent from 2017.
