



# Missouri Hogs and Pigs

Released June 27, 2019

**Missouri inventory** of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2019 was 3.55 million head, unchanged from March 1, 2019 but up 1 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 480,000 head, was up 10,000 from the previous quarter and up 20,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 3.07 million head, was down slightly from last quarter but up 1 percent from last year.

**The March-May 2019 pig crop**, at 2.56 million head, was up 4 percent from 2018. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 240,000 head, unchanged from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 10.65 for the March-May period, compared with 10.20 last year.


