



Missouri Cattle


Released January 31, 2020

All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2020 totaled 4.35 million head, 2 percent above January 1, 2019. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 2.16 million head, are up 1 percent from a year ago. The 2019 calf crop was estimated at 1.98 million head, up 2 percent from 2018.
