



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released March 31, 2020

Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2020 totaled 254 million bushels, up 13 percent from March 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 165 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 88.6 million bushels. The December 2019 - February 2020 indicated disappearance is 83.2 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2020 totaled 115 million bushels, down 14 percent from March 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 71.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 43.7 million bushels. The December 2019 - February 2020 indicated disappearance is 74.0 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2020 totaled 13.3 million bushels, down 32 percent from March 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 0.750 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 12.5 million bushels. The December 2019 - February 2020 indicated disappearance is 4.40 million bushels.
