



Missouri Crop Production

Released May 12, 2020

Winter wheat: Harvested area in 2020 is forecast at 390,000 acres, the same as last year. The winter wheat yield is forecast at 65 bushels per acre, up 2 bushels from 2019. Production is forecast at 25.4 million bushels, up 3 percent from the previous year.
