



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 30, 2020

Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 2020 totaled 164 million bushels, up 23 percent from June 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 120 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 43.8 million bushels. The March - May 2020 indicated disappearance is 89.9 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 2020 totaled 74.0 million bushels, down 16 percent from June 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 47.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 27.0 million bushels. The March - May 2020 indicated disappearance is 40.7 million bushels.

Old crop all wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 2020 totaled 11.0 million bushels, down 18 percent from June 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 0.360 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 10.7 million bushels. The March - May 2020 indicated disappearance is 2.26 million bushels.
