



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released September 30, 2020

Old crop corn stocks in all positions on September 1, 2020 totaled 54.4 million bushels, down 14 percent from September 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 25.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 29.4 million bushels. The June - August 2020 indicated disappearance is 103 million bushels.

Old crop soybean stocks in all positions on September 1, 2020 totaled 27.8 million bushels, down 43 percent from September 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 12.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 15.8 million bushels. The June - August 2020 indicated disappearance is 46.4 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on September 1, 2020 totaled 24.6 million bushels, down 7 percent from September 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 6.60 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 18.0 million bushels. The June - August 2020 indicated disappearance is 9.35 million bushels.
