



# Missouri Small Grains 2020 Summary

Released September 30, 2020

**Winter wheat:** Harvested area in 2020 is estimated at 370,000 acres, down 5 percent from the previous year. The winter wheat yield is estimated at 62 bushels per acre, down 1 bushels from 2019. Production is estimated at 22.9 million bushels, 7 percent below the previous year.

**Oats:** Harvested area in 2020, at 10,000 acres, is up 4,000 acres from the previous year. The oat yield is estimated at 43 bushels per acre, down 4 bushels from 2019. Production is estimated at 430,000 bushels, 52 percent above the previous year.
