



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released January 12, 2021

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 2020 totaled 396 million bushels, up 18 percent from December 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 285 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 111 million bushels. The September - November 2020 indicated disappearance is 217 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on December 1, 2020 totaled 158 million bushels, down 16 percent from December 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 92.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 66.4 million bushels. The September - November 2020 indicated disappearance is 160 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on December 1, 2020 totaled 16.1 million bushels, down 9 percent from December 1, 2019. On-farm stocks totaled 2.00 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 14.1 million bushels. The September - November 2020 indicated disappearance is 8.51 million bushels.
