



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released June 30, 2023

**Corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2023 totaled 137 million bushels, up 5 percent from June 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 90.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 46.7 million bushels. The March - May 2023 indicated disappearance is 113 million bushels.

**Soybean** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2023 totaled 62.1 million bushels, up 27 percent from June 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 33.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 29.1 million bushels. The March - May 2023 indicated disappearance is 63.5 million bushels.

**Old crop all wheat** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2023 totaled 8.89 million bushels, down 19 percent from June 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 0.950 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 7.94 million bushels. The March - May 2023 indicated disappearance is 5.10 million bushels.
