

# **Missouri Hogs and Pigs**

#### Released September 28, 2023

**Missouri inventory** of all hogs and pigs on September 1, 2023 was 3.40 million head, up 6 percent from June 1, 2023 and up 1 percent from last year. **Breeding inventory**, at 400,000 head, was down 35,000 from the previous quarter and down 30,000 from last year. **Market hog inventory**, at 3.00 million head, was up 8 percent from last quarter and up 3 percent from last year.

**The June-August 2023 pig crop**, at 2.62 million head, was up 4 percent from 2022. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 215,000 head, down 20,000 from a year ago. The average pigs saved per litter was 12.20 for the June-August period, compared with 10.70 last year.


