



# Missouri Grain Stocks

Released September 29, 2023

**Old crop corn** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2023 totaled 63.3 million bushels, up 85 percent from September 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 41.5 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 21.8 million bushels. The June - August 2023 indicated disappearance is 73.5 million bushels.

**Old crop soybean** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2023 totaled 21.6 million bushels, up 65 percent from September 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 9.90 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 11.7 million bushels. The June - August 2023 indicated disappearance is 40.6 million bushels.

**All wheat** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2023 totaled 41.7 million bushels, up 21 percent from September 1, 2022. On-farm stocks totaled 11.5 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 30.2 million bushels. The June - August 2023 indicated disappearance is 9.20 million bushels.
