



Missouri Grain Stocks

Released March 28, 2024

Corn stocks in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 289 million bushels, up 16 percent from March 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 200 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 89.3 million bushels. The December 2023 - February 2024 indicated disappearance is 118 million bushels.

Soybean stocks in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 108 million bushels, down 14 percent from March 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 68.0 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 40.2 million bushels. The December 2023 - February 2024 indicated disappearance is 69.5 million bushels.

All wheat stocks in all positions on March 1, 2024 totaled 18.8 million bushels, up 35 percent from March 1, 2023. On-farm stocks totaled 2.90 million bushels, while off-farm stocks totaled 15.9 million bushels. The December 2023 - February 2024 indicated disappearance is 12.9 million bushels.
