2008-2012 SMALL GRAIN FINAL COUNTY ESTIMATES

USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) has published final county estimates for Small Grains, for the production years 2008 through 2012.

The data series includes county-level planted acres, harvested acres, yield and production estimates of barley for Arizona, Colorado, Montana, Utah, and Wyoming; oats for Montana; Durum wheat for Arizona and Montana; spring wheat for Colorado and Montana; and winter wheat for Colorado, Montana, New Mexico, and Wyoming.

The estimates, based primarily on surveys conducted with farmers and ranchers during the fall of each year, can be accessed using the QuickStats online database, found here: http://www.nass.usda.gov/Quick_Stats/
