## **Crop Progress Reports Affected by Lapse in Federal Funding**

LINCOLN, Neb. February 20, 2019 – The U.S. Department of Agriculture announced earlier this year that the National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) has cancelled or postponed publication of selected USDA statistical reports impacted by the lapse in federal funding.

NASS's Crop Progress reports scheduled for January 2<sup>nd</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> were cancelled. The next scheduled release for this report is Monday, February 25<sup>th</sup>.
