NEBRASKA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

LINCOLN, Neb. January 2, 2024 - For the week ending December 31, 2023, topsoil moisture supplies rated 17% very short, 35% short, 44% adequate, and 4% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 28% very short, 38% short, 34% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 4% very poor, 12% poor, 36% fair, 35% good, and 13% excellent.

The next report will be issued January 29, 2024.
