2020 NEBRASKA SMALL GRAIN ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION

LINCOLN, Neb. September 30, 2020 - Winter wheat production is estimated at 34.0 million bushels, down 38% from last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The area harvested for grain totaled 830,000 acres, down 14% from 2019. Planted acreage totaled a record low 900,000, down 16% from a year earlier. The yield is 41.0 bushels per acre, down 16 bushels from last year.

Oat production is estimated at 1.83 million bushels, up 61% from 2019. Area harvested for grain, at 29,000 acres, is up 61% from last year. Planted acreage totaled 135,000, up 13% from a year earlier. Average yield is 63.0 bushels per acre, unchanged from 2019.
