## NEBRASKA CATTLE ON FEED UP 1 PERCENT

LINCOLN, Neb., July 22, 2011 -- Nebraska feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.02 million cattle on feed on July 1, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Nebraska Field Office. The inventory was up 1 percent from last year.

Placements in feedlots during June totaled 310,000 head, the same as last year.

Marketings of fed cattle during June totaled 465,000 head, up 7 percent from last year. Other disappearance during June totaled 15,000 head, the same as last year.

## U.S. CATTLE ON FEED UP 4 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 10.5 million head on July 1, 2011. The inventory was 4 percent above July 1, 2010.

Placements in feedlots during June totaled 1.70 million, 4 percent above 2010.

Marketings of fed cattle during June totaled 2.10 million, 5 percent above 2010. Other disappearance totaled 70,000 during June, 27 percent above 2010.
