NEBRASKA MILK PRODUCTION

LINCOLN, NE, November 1, 2013 -- Milk production in Nebraska during the July- September 2013 quarter totaled 283 million pounds, down 6 million pounds from the July- September quarter last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows, at 54,000 head, was down 2,000 head from the July-September 2012 quarter.
