## NEBRASKA MILK PRODUCTION

LINCOLN, NE, April 21, 2014 -- Milk production in Nebraska during the January- March 2014 quarter totaled 291 million pounds, down two percent from the January- March quarter last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 53,000 head.
