2015 NEBRASKA SMALL GRAIN ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION

LINCOLN, NE, September 30, 2015 – **Winter wheat** production is estimated at 46.0 million bushels, down 35 percent from last year. The area harvested for grain totaled 1.21 million acres, down 17 percent from 2014. Planted acreage totaled 1.49 million, down 4 percent from a year earlier. The yield is 38.0 bushels per acre, down 11.0 bushels from last year.

Oat production is estimated at 2.68 million bushels, up 34 percent from 2014. Area harvested for grain, at 40,000 acres, is up 33 percent from last year. Planted acreage totaled 135,000, up 23 percent from a year earlier. Average yield is a record 67.0 bushels per acre, down 13.0 bushels from 2014.
